






Facts about St. Mary's Transportation

 There are nine public transit routes that travel along main roads throughout St. Mary's County.

 Public transit routes operate at least 12 hours daily (6am -- 6pm), during peak morning and afternoon commuting travel times, with a few routes extending into the evenings.

 All routes operate Monday through Friday with five routes operating Saturday and one running Sunday as well.

 The roads traveled have average daily traffic over 10,000 vehicles, with roads in the Lexington Park area exceeding 30,000 vehicles daily.

 In addition to the public transit routes, STS operates both demand-response and ADA service, where destinations are based on passenger need. Routes vary daily.
